師資專業完善 | 課程齊備多元

本校超過30名IB教師於正式授課前皆經過嚴謹的培訓，教學品質穩定可靠。此外，我們開設的科目豐富多樣，如自然科學領域，即包含物理、化學、生物、運動與健康科學等科目。如此多元且齊備的課程規劃，有助於學生順利銜接未來大學科系，無論孩子的志向為人文、理工或藝術領域，皆可於高中階段預先修習相關學分，為相關專業領域的知識與技能奠定穩固基礎。

政府經費挹注 | 本土國際共學

本校為臺灣第一所公立國際高中，亦為桃園市首間取得IBDP授權之學校。除了招收本地學生就讀外（簡稱IB班），另設有教育部國教署海外子女攬才專班（簡稱海攬班），提供擁有專業技術之居臺國際人才之子女進入本校就讀IBDP體制之機會，可促進本校臺灣學子與多元文化背景之外籍生進行語言與文化交流。另外，本校於學費、教學設備及各項教育資源，同時獲得中央與地方政府經費完善補助，大幅降低學子經濟負擔，讓學生在公立體系中亦能享有高品質的國際教育。各項收費與補助項目皆公開透明，相關資訊歡迎至本校官網查詢。

鄰近高鐵捷運 | 交通往返便利

此外，本校設有學生宿舍，讓交通不便的學生亦可安心就讀。地理位置更是便利，距離桃園高鐵站約八百公尺、機場捷運領航站僅三百公尺，騎乘YouBike約八分鐘即可抵達，通學往返頗具便捷之利。

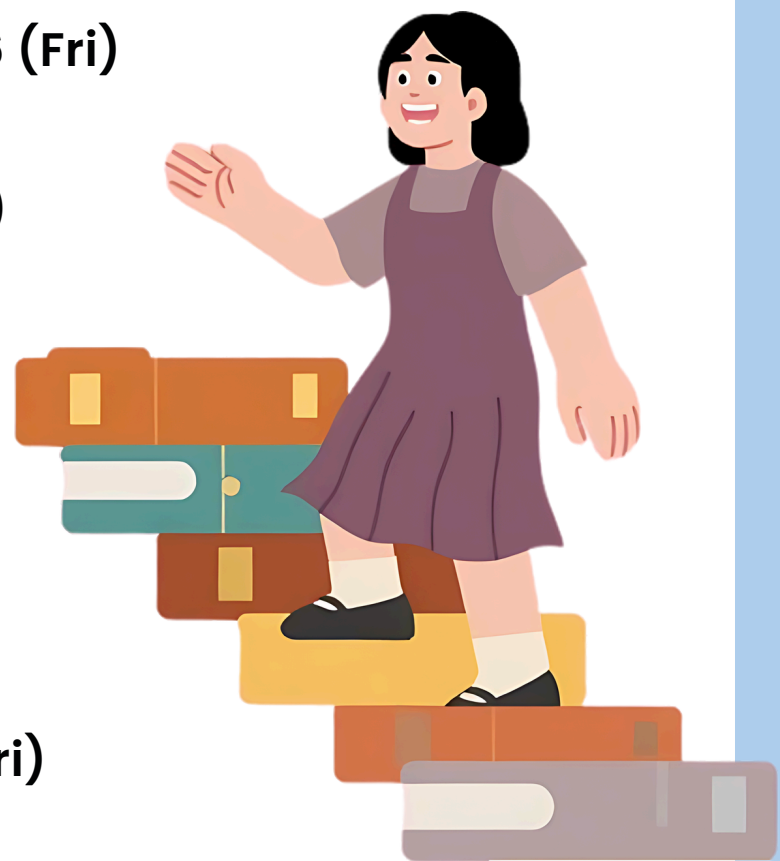

Our School

Taoyuan Municipal Dayuan International Senior High School (DYISH), established in 2010, is a municipal and co-educational school that recruits students from ages 16 to 18 (Grade 10–12), and there are 45 classes in total with approximately 1,500 students. Since its establishment, DYISH is known for its teaching of foreign languages, and there are four languages for required course selection: Japanese, French, German, and Spanish. DYISH offers a two-track education system, one of which is the General High School Curriculum, and the other is the IBDP (authorized in 2021). Any student who qualifies for and chooses the IBDP and meets the DP and DYISH graduation requirements will receive double diplomas from the IBO and DYISH under the Experimental Education Programme, respectively.

Our Academic Program

For students taking the IBDP pathway, the Grade 10 curriculum includes Chinese, English, mathematics, natural sciences, humanities, physical education, art, and other subjects. The students are taught using IB inquiry-based teaching methods to help them prepare for the Diploma Programme (DP).

In Grades 11 and 12, students take IBDP subjects. According to IBO regulations, they must choose three Standard Level (SL) subjects and three Higher Level (HL) subjects from six subject groups, and satisfactorily complete the DP core components: the Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS). Students must also meet the Ministry of Education (MOE) requirements to graduate.

Most IBDP students apply to overseas universities, though some choose to apply to Taiwanese universities.

Co-curricular Activities

At DYISH, every IB student engages for at least 18 months in meaningful CAS (Creativity, Activity, Service) experiences and completes at least two independent projects. Through this empowering process (investigation, preparation, action with reflections), students develop IB Learner Profile attributes, leadership, and responsibility, contributing positively to society in line with the IB mission. CAS in DYISH spans diverse areas such as animal protection, environmental conservation, anti-bullying, refugee support, music, arts, and sports. We also offers a wide range of clubs, student organizations, and athletic teams, giving students abundant opportunities for growth and choice.
